Dr. Pierre Guy is Associate Professor and clinician-scientist, Department of Orthopaedics, UBC. His medical training and residency were completed at McGill University, followed by orthopaedic trauma fellowships in Hannover and Berlin, Germany and at UBC. Dr. Guy also holds a Master's degree (MBA) from the John Molson School of Business, Concordia University. He is a practicing Orthopaedic Trauma Surgeon at BC's level 1 Trauma Centre, Vancouver General Hospital. He is an active member of the Canadian Orthopaedic Association and the Orthopaedic Trauma Association. He is Director of the Centre for Hip Health and Mobility at UBC, where he collaborates with engineers and biostatisticians and their trainees in research in surgery and hip fracture care. He co-leads BC Hip Fracture Redesign, a province-wide quality Improvement project.

Dr Guy joined the COF Board as a Director in 2013, holding positions on the Investment Committee and Governance & Nominating Committee. He became Vice Chair in 2016 prior to his election as Chair in July 2018.
